Tilapia 2011

We haven't heard from all of you, but we have heard from quite a few pond owners that used tilapia this season and the feedback has been very positive. Are tilapia a magic bullet for a picture perfect pond, no. They are however, a very safe and effective tool at managing algae and excessive plant growth in your pond. 2011 was our second year to offer tilapia and 99 out of 105 pond owners that tried them in 2010 came back for the 2011 season.
